IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT TODAY'S ELECTION!

On December 12, 2017, two separate elections will be held in your precinct:



U.S. Senate Special General Election

➔ Every registered voter is eligible to participate in the U.S. Senate General Election.



Alabama House District 4 Special Primary Election

➔ To vote in the Alabama House District 4 Special Primary Election, you must reside in Alabama House District 4. If you are unsure of your district, please see the poll workers.

To vote in each of these elections, you will need to present yourself to the poll workers designated for each special election. **You must check in separately for each election.** You cannot sign in at the same table for both elections.

Please follow these procedures to vote:

- I. **U.S. Senate Special General Election**
 - a. Present yourself to the poll worker who has the list of registered voters for the U.S. Senate Special General Election
 - b. Provide your name and valid photo ID to the poll worker
 - c. Sign the voter's list
 - d. Receive your ballot from the ballot clerk
 - e. Mark your ballot
 - f. Insert your ballot in the voting machine designated for the U.S. Senate Special Election

- II. **Alabama House District 4 Special Primary Election**
 - a. Present yourself to the poll worker who has the list of registered voters for the Alabama House District 4 Primary Election
 - b. Provide your name and valid photo ID to the poll worker
 - c. Declare the political party in which primary you wish to vote
 - d. Sign the voter's list for your chosen political party
 - e. Receive your ballot from the ballot clerk
 - f. Mark your ballot
 - g. Insert your ballot in the voting machine designated for the Alabama House District 4 Special Primary Election
