Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to change the name of the State Board of Education to the Alabama Board of Education, to provide for Secondary Education; to provide for the appointment of the members of the Board of Education by the Governor, subject to confirmation by the Senate; to change the name of the State Superintendent of Education to the State Superintendent of Secondary Education; to provide for the appointment of the secretary of the Board of Education, subject to confirmation by the Senate; and to authorize the Governor to appoint a secretary of the Board of Education, subject to confirmation by the Senate, to advise the commission on matters relating to the functioning and duties of the State Department of Education.
