PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO APPEAR ON THE BALLOT STATEWIDE PROPOSED STATEWIDE AMENDMENT NUMBER ONE Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama to change the name of the State Board of Education to the Alabama Commission on Elementary and Secondary Education; to provide for the appointment of the members of the commission by the Governor, subject to confirmation by the Senate, and to change the name of the State Superintendent of Education to the Secretary of Elementary and Secondary Education; to provide for the appointment of the secretary by the commission, subject to confirmation by the Senate, and to authorize the Governor to appoint a team of local educators and other officials to advise the functioning and matters relating to the commission and duties of the State Department of Education.
