Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to change the name of the State Board of Education to the Alabama Commission on Higher Education, to provide for the appointment of the members of the commission by the Governor, subject to confirmation by the Senate, to change the name of the State Superintendent of Education to the Secretary of Elementary and Secondary Education, to provide for the appointment of the secretary by the commission, subject to confirmation by the Senate, and to authorize the Governor to appoint a team of local educators and other individuals to study the issues and matters relating to the functioning and duties of the State Department of Education.
