STATEWIDE AMENDMENT 1

Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, to provide for the election of a Lieutenant Governor if the Office of Lieutenant Governor becomes vacant during the first two years of a term, to authorize the Legislature to set the salary of the Lieutenant Governor and officers of the Legislature, and to require any expenditure of legislative funds for travel to be approved by a legislative officer. (Proposed by Act 2026-341)

STATEWIDE AMENDMENT 2

Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, to provide a process for the creation of a consolidated county school system by merging two or more contiguous county boards of education; to require the State Board of Education to conduct an impact study on the potential effects of the consolidation; to require publication of the impact study; to provide a procedure for protesting a proposed consolidation of two or more county school systems; and to require the State Board of Education to adopt rules. (Proposed by Act 2026- 378)

Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, to require local boards of education to adopt policies requiring each public K-12 school to recite The Pledge of Allegiance to the United States flag at the beginning of each school day; and to require local boards of education to adopt a policy authorizing student-initiated and student-led prayer. (Proposed by Act 2026-379)

(Section 66-10.00 and Section 217(f),
Constitution of Alabama of 2022)

Shall the governing body of Wilcox County, Alabama, in order to renew, continue and preserve the current rate of ad valorem taxation in the County, be authorized to levy and collect, at the rate of 19 mills per dollar (\$1.90 per \$100) of the assessed value of taxable property in the County, the special ad valorem tax provided for under Section 66-10.00 of the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, which authorization, if approved, will effect an increase in the rate of said tax of 9 mills; said increase to be allocated and apportioned (i) 7 mills to the Wilcox County Board of Education for public school purposes and (ii) 2 mills to Wilcox County for deposit into the general fund of the County; said increase to be effective for each tax year of the County commencing with the tax year that will begin on October 1, 2027 (for which taxes will become due and payable on October 1, 2028); and said increase to become effective simultaneous with expiration of a 9-mill special ad valorem tax levied in the County for the benefit of the said Board of Education and the County, all to the end that there be no net increase in the present rate of taxation in the County?
